I don't go on anymore because I can't simply enjoy my favorite blogs without running into politics and stupid people arguing.

Probably a little excessive on the needles apps (Facebook, Snapchat) and less than it should be with things that are more productive like WordPress and Twitter.

I use various social media platforms very differently... Facebook I mostly use for the Messenger & Group features, and to keep up to date with my friends. I don't post often at all. Instagram is more common, and I mostly post cosplay pictures there. I never use Twitter, Google+, or MySpace, though I have accounts with all of them. I use Pinterest for gathering resources and ideas: resources for future cosplays, pictures of hair colors and styles or makeup looks I want to try, and so forth. So I don't really use it in a social way at all. I'm not at all consistent about using Tumblr, Reddit, or Imgur. When I do use them, it's mostly to browse and rarely to post (though I used to be pretty active on Tumblr). I keep my LinkedIn profile pretty up-to-date, but I rarely use the social features (posting, liking, commenting).

I use social media mostly to connect with strangers. My facebook pages are either for my entertainment profile or my small business. My "personal" page is rarely used. Tumblr is largely a venting platform that I have a few friends on, but not close friends. I also have a sideblog that I post screenshots from a video game I play. Twitter is more of the same.

I mostly use Facebook and Imgur, both primarily for entertainment purposes. Facebook is also use to keep up with friends lives, and post updates on mine. Imgur I almost never post content of my own, just look at other users.

I use my facebook accounts to keep track of my various friends and family members who don't always remember to keep me informed of things. I use twitter to enter contest and rarely use it for anything else. I use LinkedIn when job hunting and used for profession connections. Reddit is just to look at pictures, gifs, and videos that I would otherwise not see when I have down time.

Facebook is used to keep in touch with my friends back home. (Rarely used more than 20 mins)

Twitter is used for me to follow content creators, and to make online friends. (I use this at least 30-60 mins every other day)

Instagram is used to promote my art and misc things I play or take pictures of. (Rarely used)

Reddit/Imgur are used for entertainment via memes and gifs (daily)

Twitch is used for me to stream my games, and watch speedrunners, and musicians I follow and chat with fans (I use this the most)

I mostly use Twitter to keep track of current events, while Facebook is a good platform to follow the social lives of friends and family. I rarely post on either platform. I use Snapchat exclusively to communicate with my immediate family.

I use it when I'm bored and when I'm doing exciting things. I also use it to share news stories (especially on Twitter)

It's mostly consumptive. I occasionally comment, and rarely post. I use it occasionally throughout the day, mostly Facebook.

I mostly observe and 'like' things that other users post. I post occasionally, usually vacation photos (So my long distance family can see what I'm up to) or animal videos. I do not text regularly, so Facebook and Snapchat allow me to casually stay in touch with more distant friends

I use it to keep up with friends. I check it once in the morning and before bed.

Mostly when I'm bored. Just to check in on people, live vicariously through them I guess. I try to be funny. It works sometimes.

I use social media to keep up with friends and find events happening around me. I don't post on traditional sites like Facebook or Instagram much, but use Snapchat just to talk to my friends about daily activities. I have found that when I delete my apps, I use these sites less.

I mostly use social media to keep up with the world and with others - I don't post a lot of original content myself, and when I do it's usually pictures. Instagram is my favorite platform because pictures are my favorite form of communication and because of its really simple interface. Facebook has gotten more and more complicated and I've posted less and less because of it - I mostly use it to keep up with other peoples' lives and to follow brands and news outlets. My favorite thing to see on Facebook is, again, pictures of other peoples' lives. However, even though I don't create a lot of my own Facebook content, it's easily the social media that I consume the most, maybe 2 or more hours a day. I used to use Tumblr a lot more, but I feel like now that I have two jobs and am busy a lot, I don't use it at all really. Pinterest confuses me so I'll occasionally pin things, but I don't really get it. Snapchat I mostly use to see other peoples' Stories, but I don't have unlimited data and I don't feel like it fills a niche that I have in my life. On Twitter, I retweet a lot of things, but I rarely create my own tweets. I use social media the most in the morning and at night.

I use them to stay up to date with friends and family

Most of my social media use is for entertainment, but I use certain platforms like Twitter for reading news and other information about topics I care about. I use Instagram the most out of all the mentioned platforms. But even then, I post a picture every few days-week. As opposed to Facebook, I like that I can choose who to follow and what shows up in my Instagram newsfeed, while still allowing people to follow me who want to but not having to follow them back if I don't like the content that they post.

I use Twitter for creative purposes. I mostly follow authors, publishers, agents, and book bloggers. The content I post on Twitter is usually related to the field of writing.

Facebook I mainly use for either networking or just keeping in touch with others. I look at it every day, but I only really post something new if it's relevant, relatable and/or interesting. I also like seeing popular news stories on Facebook because I can then read brief descriptions of occurrences and then do additional research on the subject afterward.

Instagram is literally just for sharing creative pictures of experiences and projects I've worked on.

Snapchat is kind of a fad method of social media, but it also plays into keeping in touch with friends

I use it for interacting with groups/people not geographically near me. I use it to organize various groups for work. I use it to keep in touch with family and friends.

Rarely would I describe it as productive or "relaxing". It takes up more time than it should, and it kind of traps you in.

Not everything I'm passionate about is appropriate in education work circles (mostly body art, sex positive activism, sex toys and fetish culture)

Because I am a former school social worker and have connections with former students. I am very active and opinionated politically and I don't want to use my status with those students to influence them. They are mostly people with disabilities and it wouldn't be fair.

I dunno if I even do it correctly. All I know is that I have to be careful about what I post on Facebook and Tumblr when it comes to politics, religion, and other controversial topics. If future employers look at social media accounts then caution should be taken.

I don't want my personal life to mix with business because if something I say or do doesn't fit in with the company I work for it could come back to produce a negative image for the company, or for me and how I might be treated by coworkers/the company.

I know that it's important to have a visible social media presence as a prospective employee - employers want to believe that you're not hiding something from them, but also that you act in a way that will represent the company well. It's important to be cognizant of the ways in which different social platforms are used and who will be encountering your information on them. For instance, I can post cosplay pictures to Instagram because it's not an offensive or outrageous activity, so it's fine for potential employers to see it, but it's also not how I would present myself in the workplace, so it's not appropriate for LinkedIn.

I believe that my personal persona should be held private and not everything needs to be out on social media. My professional persona allows me to be honest, but still protect my privacy and home life.

Much of what I post on professional venues would be only tangentially related to the personal, and vice versa. It would just annoy the respective audiences.

My work is not one that is allowed to receive much media attention, so i do not post about it. I also try to keep a separation between my social life and my work life in real life, so I do in social media as well. I think it makes me a more professional person to not discuss work on social media

As a black woman, I do not want to be perceived one way before my employer even knows me and my qualification.

In different sites yes but in Facebook I just change privacy settings deeming a professional persona unnecessary. I also don't talk about my job/ where I work on social media

Professional me and personal me are different

For my future

I have nothing professionally related on my social media. I don't post inappropriate things, but I occasionally "like" politically geared items and it's inappropriate to be representing my profession and promoting a political affiliation.

Learned the hard way at work; personal information can become work gossip in the wrong hands. Purged my FB of work "friends" and limited my "friends" to family and personal friends, only.

I do not want to be seen by friends as too professional or not being myself; I do not want future employers to take me less seriously due to my social media

Social media presence and footprints are known to follow you forever. In efforts to pursue and be a successful professional, I am cautious about what information I share with whom.

My professional network does not need to know what's happening in my personal life.

I don't have two accounts for different personas, but I do use different social media platforms for different elements of my life. Facebook and Instagram are the personal elements of my life, while LinkedIn is my professional journey and connections.

My professional persona really isn't present on social media - I am not connected with people from work/school, and I don't share details about where I work or what I do, for the most part.

I feel it is important to keep work and personal life separate. I will not connect with the same people on LinkedIn that I would on Facebook and I would not post the same content on Twitter that I would on LinkedIn. My career is different from my creative professions and I want to represent both accurately without giving the chosen audiences too many conflicting views.

I don't really have a personal social media persona. I keep it all personally professional. Doesn't really represent myself

I need to maintain a professional persona on pretty much everything because I don't want something unprofessional to interfere with my career, but not Snapchat because I only use that with a few friends.

My personal beliefs don't always align with the organizations I am representing and visa versa.

I work in a very conservative industry and people may question my professional judgement based on my social media posts

I don't want mt high school students to find me and I've always believed that the best way to get to know a person is in person and not throigh text.

Some parts of my personal life are irrelevant to my professional life and I would rather they not be linked. Also, I sometimes post about politics in my personal life but am committed to maintaining a nonpartisan image in my professional life.

I find that I appreciate being able to talk about current events/pop culture with my friends in a more relaxed way than I would with coworkers or potential employers.

Now, I separate it because what I do for work does not involve a lot of the things I do in my personal life.

When I started integrating my personal business into social media, I will probably mix the two.

I can be professional on one for family and a little more risky for the other.

I think they must be to some degree separated, but see previous long form response

Professional sites are specifically for that, LinkedIn, and does not need to be mixed in with my social site.

My professional persona is very straight-laced. My Twitter, IG and FB are "clean" versions of myself. I try not to curse too much (but I will retweet profanity) and I don't post about partying/drinking/substance use on these profiles. I will share content of that sort on Snapchat and Tumblr which are more private.
